Using correct pronouns is a fundamental way to show respect and affirm someone's identity. It fosters an inclusive and welcoming environment for all students.

Best Practices

- Introduce yourself with your pronouns and invite others to do the same.
- Include a pronoun field on name tags or sign-in sheets.
- Respect and use the pronouns someone shares with you.
- If you make a mistake, apologize, correct yourself, and move on.
