What are Student Learning Outcomes (SLO)?

Student Learning Outcomes: Knowledge, skills, abilities, and attitudes that a student has attained at the end (or as a result) of his or her engagement in a particular set of collegiate experiences.

Areas to Assess:

SLO's are written and assessed at below levels:

- Course
- Program
- Institutional
- Service Areas (SAO)

To assure Academic Quality and Institutional Effectiveness, the institution defines and assesses student learning outcomes for all instructional programs and student and learning support services. (Eligibility Requirements 11)

LAHC SLO Procedure:

The college is generally on a four-year assessment cycle meaning that SLOs must be completed within 4 years; however, due to accreditation, in Fall 2021 the college implemented a three-year assessment cycle that ended in Fall 2023. In Spring 2024, the college started the first of its four-year assessment cycle. In order to have an effective SLO system the college requires many people to work together to assess, report, analyze and implement the process. The SLO Coordinator provides direction for the entire campus. The Department Chairs/Discipline Coordinators provide direction for the departments/disciplines. Then the Course Coordinators plan and create the SLOs in eLumen for the courses that will be assessed in a given semester. The last step is for faculty to enter their results, both the qualitative and quantitative results. The results are then analyzed by the departments so that coordinators can implement any changes to improve instruction and the results are also reported in the Program Review.

The SLO Assessment Committee is comprised of members that represent the LAHC Divisions along with Administration, Staff and Resources. The SLO Assessment Committee meets once a month to discuss SLO updates for the semester, collaboration with Curriculum, eLumen updates and future goals. The members of the committee report back to their divisions to keep them updated on SLO requirements. The committee advises the SLO Coordinator on how to plan, promote and coordinate all SLO related concerns. In addition, the SLO Coordinator works collaboratively with the Curriculum Committee for the development, content and application of SLOs in the instructional process.

Currently, eLumen is partnering with a company called Coursedog. Until fall 2027, eLumen will remain the curriculum management system. In the long term, Coursedog does intend to phase out eLumen's curriculum management system. LACCD may explore other curriculum management systems beyond fall 2027.

Institutional Student Learning Outcomes (ISLO):

ISLO 1 - Communication: Use oral, written, and non-verbal modes of expression appropriate to the audience and purpose.

ISLO 2 - Cognition: Use critical thinking skills and quantitative reasoning to analyze, synthesize, and evaluate ideas and information to interpret real world information in the context of a discipline.

ISLO 3 - Information Literacy and Technological Competency: Utilize technology for research and learning skills necessary to achieve educational, professional, and personal objectives.

ISLO 4 - Social Responsibility and Ethics: Demonstrate sensitivity to and respect for others by promoting equity, diversity, and success by participating as responsible citizens that empower self, others, and the community.
