WHAT IS LAND SURVEYING TECHNICIAN?

A land survey technician visits construction sites to take measurements and analyze distances, angles, and positions to develop surveys or maps. As a land survey technician, you take inventory of the site and note any information necessary for future construction or development. Your responsibilities include determining the boundaries of the site and setting out stakes and marks along the property line to conduct surveys. Other duties include collecting data from surveys and inputting the information into a digital database. Land survey technicians most commonly work for engineering or mapping companies and help the on-site surveyor with any cartography needs. Licensed Land Surveyors may prepare legal descriptions for subdividing property, perform boundary surveys and determine boundary discrepancies.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

- Most surveying and mapping technicians work for firms that provide engineering, surveying, and mapping services on a contractual basis
- Surveying technicians work outside extensively and can be exposed to all types of weather
- They often stand for long periods, walk considerable distances, and may have to climb hills with heavy packs of surveying instruments

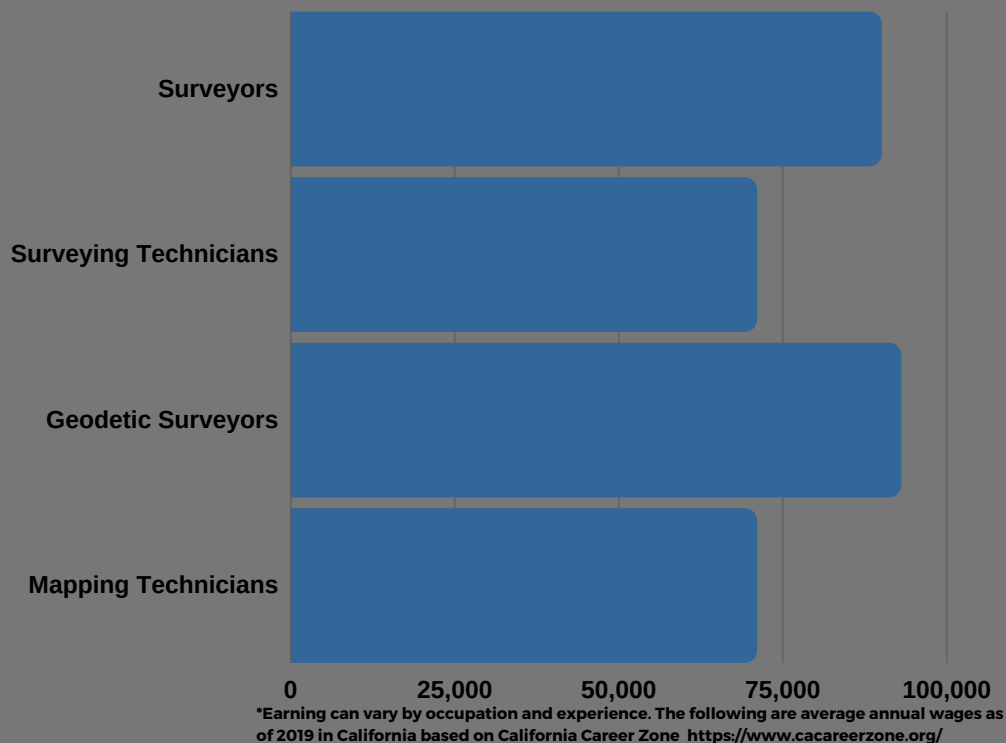
