WHAT IS NUTRITION AND DIETETICS?

Nutrition & Dietetics majors range from social sciences to biology and chemistry as they learn how dietary patterns affect human health. Nutrition majors can expect to take an introductory course on the principles of nutrition. Other topics nutrition majors might study include nutrition across the human life span, food preparation, global food availability and distribution, and nutrition as it relates to various disease states. They can use this information to help others make healthy choices for their lives, from shaping school lunch menus to educating people on what to eat, taking into consideration individual needs, age, and special circumstances such as pregnancy. As a nutrition major studies, the relationship between nutrients in food and human health. Students with this major often can choose from multiple tracks and concentrations such as, general nutrition or nutritional sciences, public health or community nutrition, pre-medicine, or dietetics, depending on their career goals.

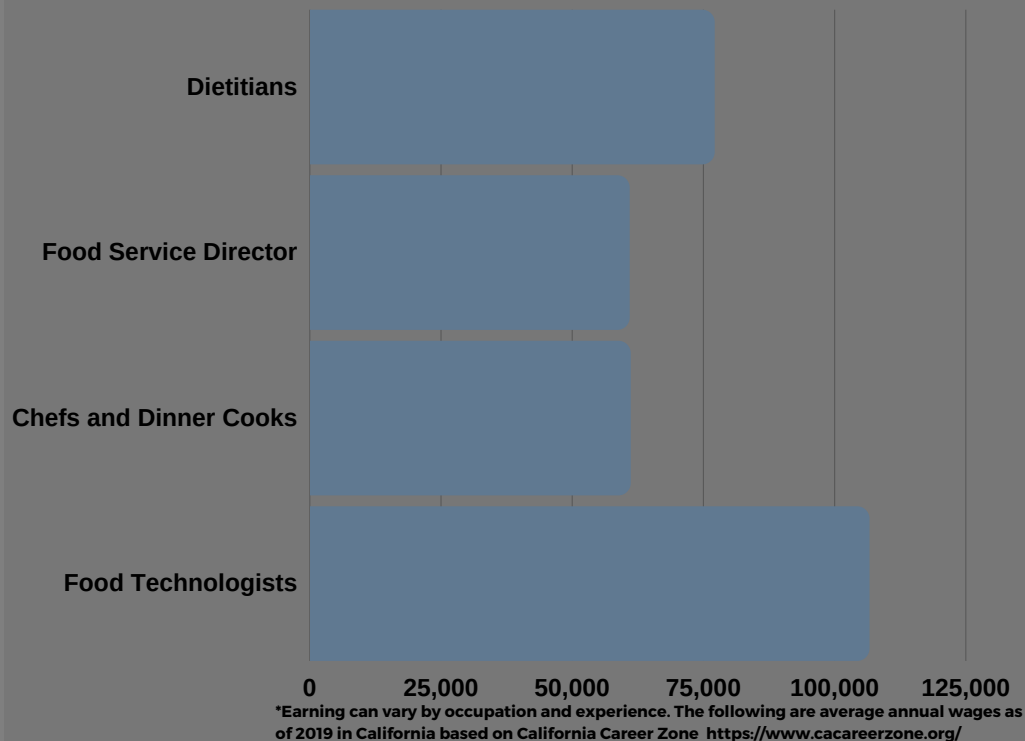
