ADAPTING TO YOUR

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, Los Angeles Southwest College (LASC) has prioritized the safety and security of our students and employees, but has also adapted to the needs that we see in our community. Our goal is to meet our community's needs by providing integral services so everyone can find success.

That is why we successfully applied for funding to build a Family Resource Center on our campus to support families by reducing barriers to graduation and livable wage careers. That is why we successfully applied for a Predominantly Black Institution grant through the United States Department of Education totaling more than \$1.7 million so we can enhance the Black student experience inside and outside of the classroom. That is why we opened the Cougars Cupboard on our campus, a food pantry that provides necessary meals and snacks to students so they can complete their studies hunger-free.

These innovative new programs and support efforts are all meant to ensure our responsiveness to meet our community's needs. This approach extends to our classrooms where students have many options to find success. On-campus and online classes. Full-term or short-term classes. Day or night classes. No matter where you may feel you will have the most success, we will be there for you.

We have so many resources that will meet you where you are and support you all the way from the registration process to your honored walk across the graduation stage. We are here to ensure your success. This is our vision, this is our commitment, and this is your community's college.

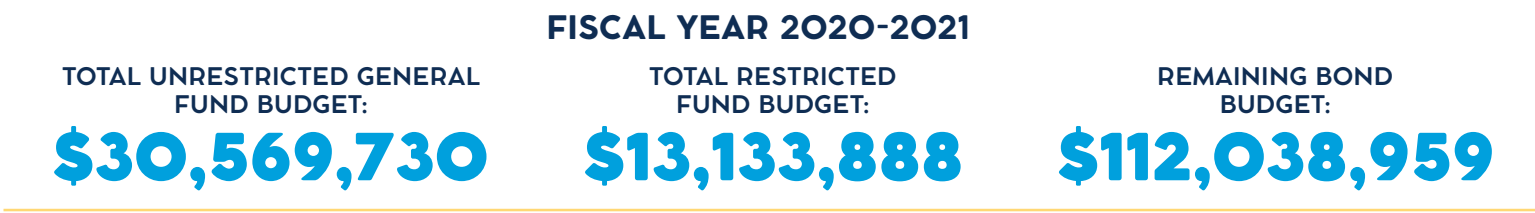
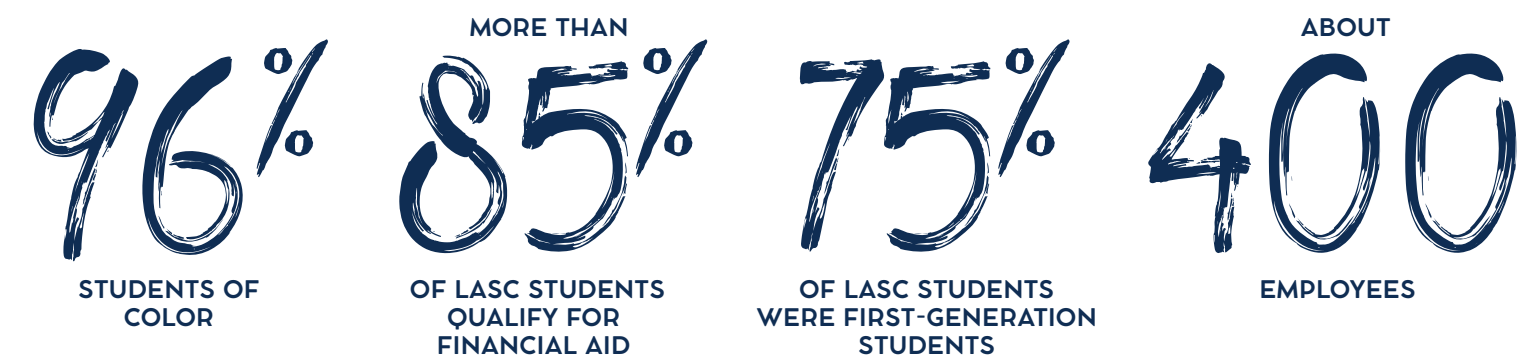

- 4 **Register for Classes** at MyCollege.laccd.edu
- 5 **Apply for Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®)** at fafsa.gov or the **Dream Act** at dream.sac.ca.gov
- 6 **Pay your Health/Parking Fee** at MyCollege.laccd.edu and **Pick Up Your Parking Permit** at the Business Office in Student Services Building, Room 103.
- 7 **Take your Student ID Picture** in the Welcome Center in Student Services Building, Room 118.

HOW TO APPLY AT LASC

You Can Apply If:

- › You have a high school diploma or its equivalent and meet the basic eligibility requirements for admission to any public, California, two-year community college.
- › You are 18 years old or older.
- › You are an apprentice as defined by Section 3077 of the California Labor Code.
- › You are a K-12 student under special circumstances.

There is no fee to apply.

High school students can enroll by visiting lasc.edu/programs/K12 and clicking the "K-12 Registration Process" button.

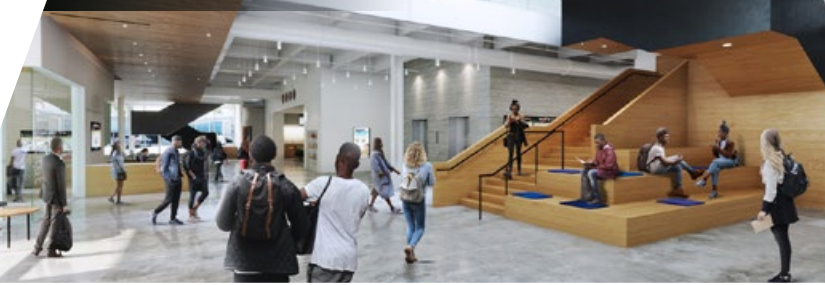

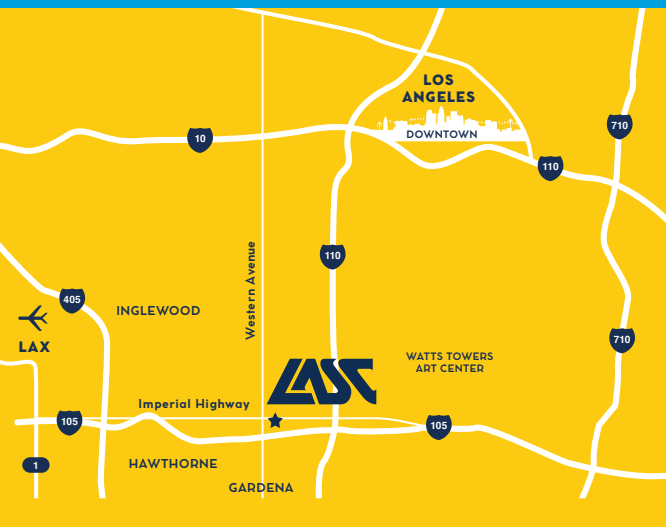
I hope most of all that this report encourages you to visit us here at LASC. No matter where you are, we will meet you, and guide you throughout your journey to graduation and beyond.
