The laboratory work presents more techniques of multi-step synthesis, isolation, purification, and analysis of organic compounds using conventional and modern instrumental methods. This course also emphasizes the use and interpretation of Nuclear Magnetic Resonance (NMR), Infrared (IR), Mass Spectroscopy (MS), Ultraviolet (UV), and Gas Chromatograph (GC) in the analysis and identification of organic compounds.

The Chem. 211 and 212 sequence satisfy the one year organic chemistry requirement for careers in the physical, biological, and health sciences and a requirement for the Associate of Sciences degree in Chemistry.
