

Women Empowerment Club Constitution

Article I – Name

The name of this organization shall be the **Women Empowerment Club**.

Article II – Purpose

The purpose of the club is to:

1. Empower women and girls through education, support, and leadership opportunities.
 2. Promote gender equality and raise awareness on women’s issues.
 3. Create a safe and inclusive space for discussion and personal growth.
 4. Organize events, workshops, and outreach activities that inspire confidence and community involvement.

Article III – Membership

1. Membership is open to all individuals who support the mission of the club.
 2. Members are expected to participate actively and respectfully.
 3. Discrimination or harassment of any kind will not be tolerated.

Article IV – Officers

The club shall have the following officers:

- **President:** Leads meetings, represents the club, and oversees activities.
- **Vice President:** Assists the President and takes over when needed.
- **Secretary:** Keeps records, meeting notes, and manages communication.
- **Treasurer:** Manages funds and keeps track of the budget.
- **ICC Rep:** Reports on activities that other clubs on campus are having. And shares information exchange about upcoming events, and creates an opportunity for clubs to collaborate and work together.

Elections shall be held once a year. Officers serve for one year and can be re-elected.

Article V – Meetings

1. The club shall meet **at least once a month**.
 2. Special meetings can be called by the President or by request of members.
 3. A quorum (minimum of 50% of active members) is needed for official decisions.

Article VI – Amendments

1. Any member may propose changes to the constitution.
 2. Amendments must be approved by a **two-thirds vote** of active members.

Article VII – Dissolution

In case the club dissolves, any remaining funds or assets shall be donated to a local women's shelter or charity chosen by the members.
