Identify the center and radius of each. Then sketch the graph.

1) $(x + 2)^2 + (y - 4)^2 = 9$

2) $(x + 2)^2 + (y - 2)^2 = 1$

3) $(x - 1)^2 + (y + 3)^2 = 8$

4) $(x + 1)^2 + (y - 1)^2 = 16$

5) $(x - 1)^2 + (y - 4)^2 = 9$

6) $(x + 4)^2 + (y + 4)^2 = 2$

7) $(x + 2)^2 + (y + 1)^2 = 9$

8) $(x + 4)^2 + (y + 3)^2 = 3$

9) $(x + 1)^2 + (y - 1)^2 = 9$

10) $(x - 4)^2 + (y + 2)^2 = 4$

11) $x^2 + (y + 3)^2 = 16$

12) $x^2 + (y - 3)^2 = 2$

13) $(x + 4)^2 + (y - 3)^2 = 1$

14) $(x + 3)^2 + (y - 2)^2 = 4$

15) $(x - 4)^2 + (y + 1)^2 = 4$

16) $(x - 1)^2 + (y + 2)^2 = 25$

17) $x^2 + (y - 1)^2 = 16$

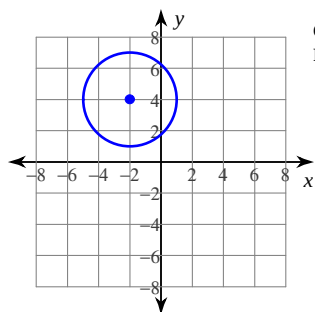
18) $(x - 4)^2 + (y + 2)^2 = 2$

20) $(x - 1)^2 + y^2 = 36$

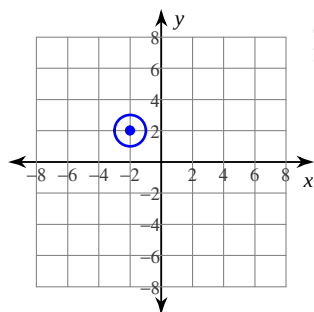

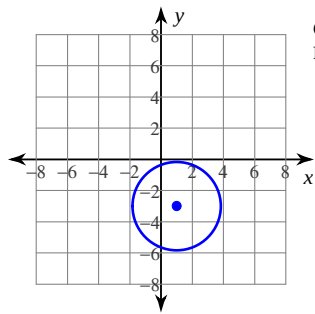

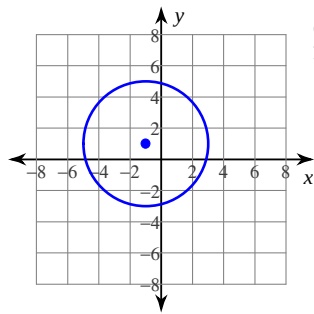

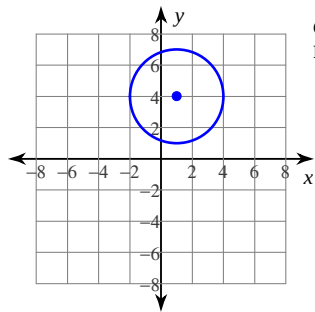

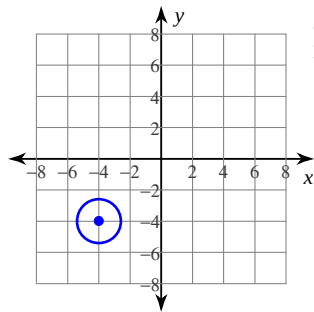

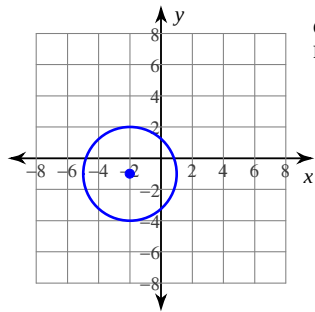

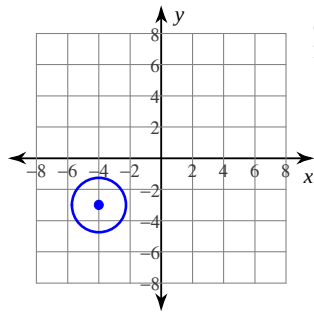

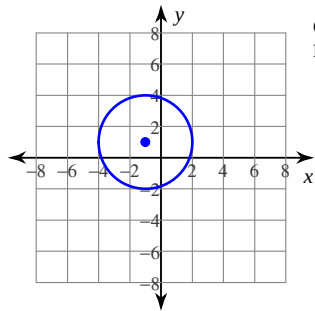

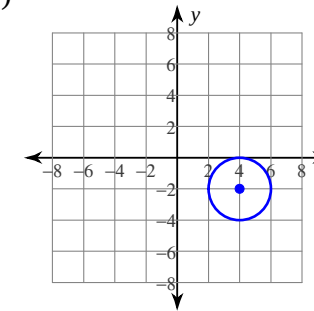

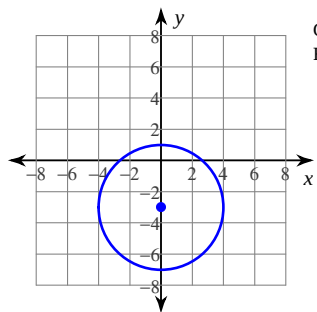

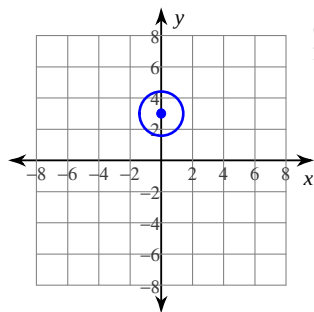

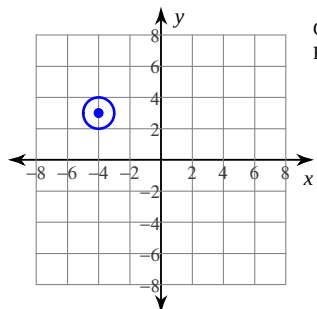

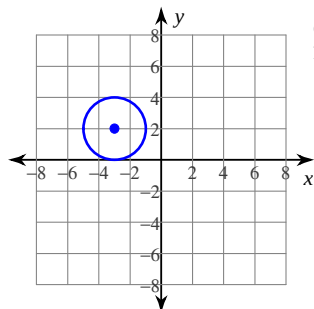
