**External Examinations**

The University of California (UC) Policy for AP credit and the California State University (CSU) Systemwide Credit for External Examinations govern the use of AP exams for awarding general education.

A score of 5, 6, or 7 on Higher Level IB exams is required to grant credit for Cal-GETC certification.

The UC Policy for IB credit and the CSU systemwide minimums policy govern the use of IB exams for awarding general education credit.

Cal-GETC policies are governed by the CSU, UC, and ICAS. The Articulation Officer has final review and determination of all courses and catalog rights applied toward Cal-GETC certification.
