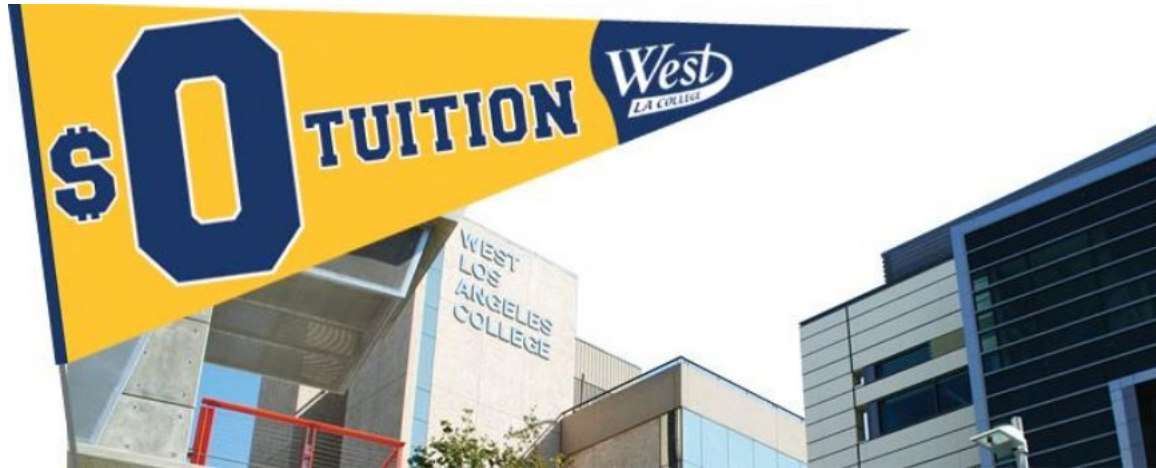

ADM JUS 001-Introduction To Administration Of Justice (UC/CSU) - 3 Units

Requirement Designation: Meets Cal-GETC-4

Philosophy, history, and theories of the criminal justice system, including the roles and functions of the local, state, and federal jurisdictions. Theories, functions, and interrelationships among criminal justice agencies; law enforcement, courts, and corrections; crime causation, correctional theory, analysis and the social impact of crime. The conceptual approach utilized in this course recognizes that criminal justice is itself a distinct academic discipline rather than an interdisciplinary course of study.

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AFRO AM 005-The African American in the History of the U.S. II (UC/CSU) - 3 Units

Requirement Designation: Meets Cal-GETC-4 & US1

This course is from the perspective of people of African ancestry and introduces students to major social and cultural events in the African American experience, from the Reconstruction Era to the present. Integrated learning strands include an overview of Black progress movements in the contexts of race, equity, gender, sexuality, Black feminism, and social justice in the contemporary Black experience. This course documents the Black societies and culture that resisted against racism, helping students understand the theories and motivations behind race-based social patterns that forged U.S. political, social, cultural and economic relations from 1865 to the present.

An overview of the functions of various public health professions and institutions, and an in-depth examination of the core public health disciplines is covered. Topics of the discipline include the epidemiology of infectious and chronic disease; prevention and control of diseases in the community including the analysis of the social determinants of health and strategies for eliminating disease, illness and health disparities among various populations; community organizing and health promotion programming; environmental health and safety; global health; and healthcare policy and management.
